

2015 AWF Club Tournament Regulations

1. State Members who wish to participate in the 2015 Club Tournament will conduct their own Capital City/Country Club qualifying round **prior to 16th August, 2015.**
2. Each State Member will determine the criteria which constitutes a City/Country team.
3. Teams will be comprised of four (4) persons including two (2) female athletes and two (2) male athletes.
4. During the qualifying round conducted in each State, team points will be calculated using combined Sinclair scores (Female Sinclair Score + Female Sinclair Score + Male Sinclair Score + Male Sinclair Score = Team Total Sinclair Score).
5. State Members will place each team into either the City League or the Country League and will rank teams within each league 1st, 2nd, 3rd...
6. State Members are to send the finalised league tables to the AWF, via email mkeelan@awf.com.au, **no later than Wednesday 19th August, 2015.**
7. On receipt of data from all State Members, submitted teams will be entered into a national ranking table for City teams and national ranking table for Country teams.
8. The top eight (8) nationally ranked City teams and the top eight (8) ranked Country teams will be invited to contest the 2015 Club Tournament Final that will be take place at the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre during the weekend of 24th/25th October, 2015.
9. Should any of the top 8 nationally ranked teams decline the invitation to contest the Club Tournament Final, teams ranked 9th will be sent a similar invitation. Should the team ranked 9th decline the invitation, the team ranked 10th will be sent a similar invitation and so on.
10. The City and Country Team Club Tournament Finals will consist of four (4) sessions of 16 athletes. Two (2) sessions will be conducted on Saturday 24th October, and two (2) sessions will be conducted on Sunday 25th October.
11. The scoring format for the Club Tournament Final will stem from Sinclair score with + or – points for new 2015 Personal Bests (PB) or failure to match 2015 PB
12. Should a lifter fail to match 2015 PB they will receive -5 points, equal 2015 PB will earn 0 points and any new PB will earn 5 points, this said, lifters have the potential to earn a max of 15pts for Sn, 15 Points for Jerk and a further 15 points for total, vice-versa they could end up with negative points being taken off their Sinclair score.
13. The winning City Team will be awarded \$1,000 and trophy.
14. The winning Country team will be awarded \$1,000 and trophy.
15. The top three ranked City and Country teams will be awarded medals
