Best and Fairest Voting Instructions

- One set of votes to be decided by a voting panel representing a minimum of two of the Referees and/or the Technical Controller who officiate the session. Each voter has equal voting rights, with the Centre Referee being responsible for convening the voting panel, and for recording the voting preferences.
- The voting panel should consider potential nominees for the best and fairest during the session.
- The voting panel should meet together at the **immediate conclusion of the session**, and be ready to nominate lifters for consideration by the other Referees.
- The voting panel should not discuss voting preferences outside the voting panel, but are allowed to request additional information from the Announcer (with regard to possible records, personal best attempts within the competition, and qualification standards etc).
- Following discussion, the Referees should allocate votes to three lifters, in the order of 3
 votes being the highest, and 1 vote being the lowest.
- When the voting panel have made their decision, the Centre Referee will write the lifters
 names in the appropriate places on the voting slip, and all members of the voting panel
 shall print their full name to confirm their agreement.

Voting Criteria:

The voting panel should make impartial judgements based on the following criteria to the best of their capability while considering votes:

- General competition etiquette and good behaviour,
- Positive interactions with other lifters and officials.
- Number of attempts successfully lifted,
- State, and/or national records broken.
- Personal bests,
- Qualifying standards
